Noalesa Abbey was founded in 726 and located in the Cenischia Valley. The Abbey belongs to the Metropolitan City of Turin, which takes care of it, and has been entrusted since 1973 to the custody of the Benedictine monks of the Cassinese Sublacensis Congregation of the Order of St. Benedict.

The monastery is dedicated to Saints Peter and Andrew at a time when the Eastern and Western Churches were not yet separated.

The abbey complex is located along the important pilgrimage route, and became a significant stop on the Via Francigena. In Carolingian times (9th century) the abbey reached the height of its splendor, welcoming more than five hundred monks.

A history not only long that of Noalesa, but rich in changes and adaptations. Benedictine Cassinese and Sublacensis monks, Cistercians and Trappists have succeeded one another in the monastery of Noalesa. A monastic laboratory of continuous adaptation and rethinking in the light of fidelity to the Gospel and history with its constraints and inspirations.

Francigena bicycle route from Caselette to Avigliana

The Ciclovía Francigena develops in the wide plain of Caselette and Almese surrounded by cultivated fields and large grassland areas at the foot of Mount Musinè. Nearby it is possible to visit, with detours in the urban area, the archaeological excavations of the Roman villas, or the Cays Castle and the Ricetto di San Mauro. Continue along the Dora until you reach the dam and metal bridge near Avigliana. From here it is possible to reach the historic center on an urban route and resume the Ciclovía towards the Avigliana Lakes.

Grappa from Comba di Susa

The Comba di Susa is an area with special characteristics in which typically Alpine plant aspects blend with others of an exquisitely Mediterranean type where holm oaks, fig trees and vines live.

Grappa della Comba di Susa is a grappa made exclusively from the distillation of local pomace contributed by numerous small wine growers in the area.

All stages of production take place in the area: grape cultivation, vinification, distillation, aging and bottling, guaranteeing the origin and typicality of the product.

Princes' Trail / From Avigliana to the Sacra di San Michele

From the hamlet of Bertassi di Avigliana from the convenient parking area in the small square, take the road uphill that runs alongside the church and becomes a mule track (marked as 501) and climbs to the hamlet of Mortera. After a short stretch of asphalt you enter the hamlet and then head toward the former convent of St. Francis at Charterhouse 1515.

- Difficulty: T - BC
- Starting point: hamlet of Mortera, Avigliana (TO) (also from Bertassi hamlet or Avigliana station)
- Point of arrival: Sacra di San Michele
- Height difference: 300 mt
- Distance: 4 km
- Walking time: 1h30 hours
